## Activities

### C-ROADS Didactic APP & Advocacy Learning Path

The aim of this activity is to develop a digital-based application that integrates learning paths to test individuals' prior skills on climate change and environmental justice, contributing to their participation at local level.

### C-ROADS Didactic Escape Rooms

The project aims to develop a new Escape Room, made up of seven adventure games, thus creating a context for individuals to solve different life challenges related to climate change and environmental justice. Through these learning exercises, participants will develop transversal learning skills (critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, communication) and life skills (flexibility, leadership, initiative, productivity and social skills), with the aim of strengthening community participation in climate action issues and accelerating positive behavior change.

### C-ROADS Thematic Photovoice & Hands on Guide for Educatorsh

This activity brings together a series of actions aimed at improving adult educators' skills in the photovoice methodology. To this end, an intensive course and a practical guide will be developed for the use of the photovoice methodology associated with the impacts of climate change at local level and the active participation of communities in minimizing them.

### Promotion, Impact and Sustainability

The C-ROADS project calls for civic participation and, in order to achieve this, it is important to ensure that its results are used by the target groups and transferred to other contexts. The aim of this activity is to disseminate information about the project, as well as the methodologies, educational materials, tools and resources developed. The results achieved will also be disseminated locally, nationally and transnationally through international public events.
